Suggested wording for your will:

“ I give % of my residuary estate
OR I give the sum of £ (pounds
only) free of all taxes to the Parochial
Church Council of the Parish of St
Gregory’s Marnhull in the Diocese of
Salisbury for its general purposes, and I
declare that the receipt of an officer of
the Parochial Church Council shall be a
sufficient discharge to my executors and
trustees.”


