It is their testimony to the faithfulness, goodness and generosity of God and their thankfulness for the life of St Gregory's.

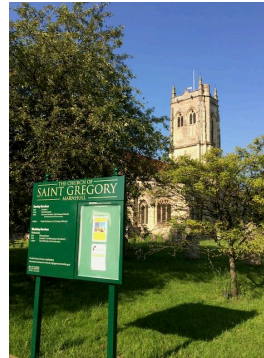
